

Ordinance 57-12

An Ordinance to reinstate longevity pay to the Service Supervisors for the City of Bexley.

**WHEREFORE**, the previous amendments to Ordinance 53-11 eliminating longevity pay for non-union employees also mistakenly eliminated longevity pay for Service Supervisors.

**WHEREAS**, Service Supervisors are to receive all rights and privileges received by their employees through the AFSCME contract.

**WHEREAS**, the original intent of Amended Ordinance 53-11 was meant to exempt Service Supervisors from the elimination of longevity pay.

**WHEREAS**, the elimination of an entire section of the policy relating to longevity pay inadvertently impacted the Service Supervisors' benefits.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:**

This ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
