An Ordinance to reinstate longevity pay to the Service Supervisors for the City of Bexley.

WHEREFORE, the previous amendments to Ordinance 53-11 eliminating longevity pay for non-union employees also mistakenly eliminated longevity pay for Service Supervisors.

WHEREAS, Service Supervisors are to receive all rights and privileges received by their employees through the AFSCME contract.

WHEREAS, the original intent of Amended Ordinance 53-11 was meant to exempt Service Supervisors from the elimination of longevity pay.

WHEREAS, the elimination of an entire section of the policy relating to longevity pay inadvertently impacted the Service Supervisors' benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

This ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
