## ORDINANCE NO. 27-14

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND DESIGNATED THE BROAD AND MAIN STREETS SIGNALS PROJECT FUND AND TO APPROPRIATE \$655,565 FROM THIS FUND TO RECORD EXPENSES RELATED TO THE PROJECT AND TO APPROPRIATE \$50,000 FROM THE ROAD AND ALLEY FUND (34) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING ENGINEERING FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE BROAD AND MAIN STREETS SIGNALS PROJECT.

Whereas: The City of Bexley has received a Federal grant in the amount of \$655,565 from the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ), and

<u>Whereas:</u> The City will use this grant to replace the existing span wire traffic signal at Gould & Main with a new mast arm traffic signal similar to others on Main Street and to replace other traffic signals on Broad Street and Main Street for improved efficiency and appearance, and

**Whereas** Engineering fees for the project are not covered by the grant.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

- <u>Section</u> 1. That \$50,000 is hereby appropriated from the Road and Alley Fund (34) for the purpose of paying engineering fees associated with the Broad and Main Streets Signals Project.
- Section 2 That a special fund designated the Broad and Main Streets Signal Project Fund is hereby established and \$655,565 is hereby appropriated from this fund to record all revenue and expenses that will be paid directly by the Ohio Department of Transportation to the City's contractors related to the Broad and Main Streets Signals Project.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
