An Ordinance to give the Mayor of the City of Bexley, Ohio the authority to negotiate a salary lower than that which appears for positions listed in Schedule One of Amended Ordinance 72-13 for new hires or present employees being promoted to a new position, retroactive to January 1, 2014.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio on December 17, 2013 passed Amended Ordinance 72-13, attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor should have the authority to negotiate lower salaries than those set forth in Amended Ordinance 72-13 for new hires and promotions from within.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor of the City of Bexley, Ohio shall have the authority to negotiate a lower salary for those positions appearing in Schedule One in Amended Ordinance 72-13, for new hires, and for those employees being promoted to a new position appearing in Schedule One in Amended Ordinance 72-13.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Mayor's authority is retroactive to January 1, 2014.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance shall take effect and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
