AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AN ADDITIONAL SERGEANT POSITION WITH THE BEXLEY POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND TO APPROPRIATE \$8,400.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND

Whereas, Bexley City Council and the Mayor of Bexley have consistently maintained that safety in Bexley is a top priority and Bexley City Council previously expressed its willingness to allocate funds to accomplish that priority; and

Whereas, in order to facilitate a more effective and efficient Bexley Police Department, the 2015 City of Bexley Budget proposal includes the creation of a new administrative and crime prevention Sergeant position; and

Whereas, rather than wait for approval of the 2015 City of Bexley Budget, Bexley City Council prefers to immediately commence the hiring process for the new Sergeant position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That an additional Sergeant position be created within the Bexley Police Department effective from and after the earliest period allowed by law and that the Bexley Police Chief is empowered to commence the hiring process for such position.

Section 2. That an additional Eight Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$8,400.00) be appropriated for 2014 from the General Fund into the Salaries & Wages account of the Police Department budget.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
