AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR, CITY ATTORNEY AND CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO TO ENTER INTO A LABOR AGREEMENT WITH THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE CAPITAL CITY LODGE NO. 9 FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2015 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2017, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the labor contract between the City of Bexley, Ohio and the Fraternal Order of Police Capital City Lodge No. 9 ("F.O.P.") will expire on December 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, negotiations between the City of Bexley, Ohio and the F.O.P. have resulted in a tentative agreement ratified by the members of Lodge No. 9; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Bexley, Ohio in order to provide for the safety and well being of its citizens, to have a labor agreement with its safety force;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

- That the Mayor, City Attorney and Chief of Police of the City of Bexley,
 Ohio are hereby authorized to enter into a labor agreement on behalf of
 the City with the Fraternal Order of Police Capital City Lodge No. 9 for the
 period of January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017.
- Section 2. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the immediate passage of which is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its citizens. Accordingly, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
