Section 6. That the provisions of this ordinance shall take effect as of January 1, 2016.

Section 7. That all ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 8. That in order to assure uninterrupted City services, this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, to be effective January 1, 2016.
