

First Amended Resolution No. 22-15

An Ordinance to establish Bexley City Council meeting dates and times for 2016.

Whereas, Section 21 of the Bexley City Charter, requires the establishment of meeting times (and dates) by ordinance or resolution of at least twice per month, except for one month in the summer season designated as vacation.

Whereas, It is beneficial to council, staff and citizens if know in advance that circumstances or holidays necessitate a change from the traditionally held 2nd and 4th Tuesdays for regular council meetings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1. The official meeting dates and times for the Bexley City Council meetings in 2016 will be as indicated in attached Schedule A, and

Section 2. Schedule A may be modified from time to time pursuant to Section 21 of the Bexley City Charter for special meetings, or by voice vote approval of a necessary change by Council at least 1 meeting prior to the meeting date indicated in Schedule A.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

An Ordinance to establish rates for the Mayor, salaried, part time and casual employees of the City of Bexley, effective as of January 1, 2016.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. That the Mayor will be paid \$107,709 in accordance with Ordinance 58-12.

Section 2. That all other elected officials of the City of Bexley are to be paid in a manner prescribed by the Charter and Ordinances.

Section 5. That all above employees will be paid either weekly or biweekly as determined by management.

Section 6. That the provisions of this ordinance shall take effect as of January 1, 2016.

Section 7. That all ordinances or parts thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 8. That in order to assure uninterrupted City services, this Ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall go into effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, to be effective January 1, 2016.
