

ORDINANCE NO. 32-15

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A TRANSFER OF \$5,000 FROM THE UNENCUMBERED GENERAL FUND TO THE POLICE OFFICER EQUIPMENT FUND AND TO APPROPRIATE \$5,000 FROM THE POLICE OFFICER EQUIPMENT FUND TO ALLOW POLICE OFFICERS TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT AUTHORIZED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR USE ON DUTY.**

**Whereas**, the City has a policy of allowing police officers to purchase optional equipment with City Funds for use on duty and to repay the City over a twelve month period, and

**Whereas**, an additional \$5,000 is needed to allow more police officers to participate in this program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That a transfer of \$5,000 from the unencumbered General Fund to the Police Officer Optional Equipment Fund is hereby authorized.

Section 2. That \$5,000 is hereby appropriated from the Police Officer Equipment Fund to allow police officers to purchase equipment authorized by the Chief of Police for use on duty.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
