An Ordinance to appropriate \$23,000 from the Street Maintenance Fund (03) to pay invoices for rock salt purchased through the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT's) Cooperative Purchasing Agreement Program.

WHEREAS the yearly purchase of rock salt is essential to maintaining the city's roadways throughout the winter months.

WHEREAS the city participates in ODOT's Cooperative Purchasing Program pertaining to rock salt annually to maximize competitive bidding options.

WHEREAS \$23,000.00 is needed to pay for cost associated with rock salt purchased as part of the ODOT's Cooperative Purchasing Summer Fill Program.

WHEREAS adequate funding is available in the Street Maintenance Fund to cover said expenses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That \$23,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Maintenance Fund (03) to pay invoices for rock salt purchased through the ODOT's Cooperative Purchasing Program agreement.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
