ORDINANCE NO. 16 - 16

An Ordinance to revise the Codified Ordinances by adopting current replacement pages.

WHEREAS, various Ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish an annual supplement to the Codified Ordinances which is before Council;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1: That the ordinances of the City of Bexley, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, re-codified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 2016 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

Section 3: That the complete text of the sections listed above is set forth in full in the current replacement pages to the codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit "A". Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.
