AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017, TO AUTHORIZE A 2016 TRANSFER FROM THE UNENCUMBERED GENERAL FUND TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND of \$500,000 AND TO CONFIRM THE APPOINTMENT OF MARC FISHEL AS CITY ATTORNEY for 2017.
