

ORDINANCE NO. 47 - 16

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley with the Franklin County Board of Health for the provision of health department and plumbing inspection services to the City of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the 2017 Franklin County Board of Health contract, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", has been prepared for review by the City; and

WHEREAS, engaging with the Franklin County Board of Health for health department services continues to provide a more affordable and effective solution compared to having a department in-house or contracting with any adjacent Cities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1.

That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the 2017 Franklin County Public Health Services Contract in a substantially similar form as that attached to this Ordinance as "Exhibit A".

Section 2.

That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, such necessity arising so that the Board of Health Contract can be executed and active on January 1, 2017, and therefore this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
