

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 01 – 17

An Ordinance to authorize the Mayor to execute a grant agreement with the State of Ohio for the environmental cleanup and remediation of the site located at 2106 East Main Street; to create an agency fund designated the 2106 East Main Street Environmental Cleanup Fund ; and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, The City has worked with the property owner of 2106 East Main Street to secure funding for the environmental remediation of the petroleum contaminated site; and

Whereas, The State of Ohio grant program that has been awarded to the project requires the City of Bexley to be the grantee of record and that all funds being expended through the grant be processed through the City of Bexley;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1:

That the Grant Agreement attached as "Exhibit A" be approved, and that the Mayor and City Auditor be authorized to execute the agreement.


Section 2:

That an agency fund designated the 2106 East Main Street Environmental Cleanup Fund is hereby created.

Section 4.

That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare, and shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


