AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL FUND DESIGNATED THE ASHBOURNE AND ROOSEVELT PROJECT FUND TO RECORD ALL REVENUE AND EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE ASHBOURNE AND ROOSEVELT RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, TO APPROPRIATE \$5,548,001 FROM THIS FUND TO PAY FOR THE COST OF THE PROJECT, TO AUTHORIZE TRANSFERS FROM THE WATER, SEWER AND ROAD AND ALLEY FUNDS OF \$438,402, \$65,760 AND \$43,840 RESPECTIVELY TO THE ASHBOURNE AND ROOSEVELT PROJECT FUND AND TO REDUCE THE APPROPRIATION IN THE ROAD AND ALLEY FUND FOR THE ANNUAL STREET PROGRAM BY \$43,840.

Whereas: The City of Bexley has received financing from the State of Ohio in the form of a \$1,249,999 grant and a \$3,750,000 interest free loan from the Ohio Public Works Commission for the Ashbourne and Roosevelt Improvements Project, and

Whereas: The City's matching share is \$548,002, and

Whereas: The revenues and expenditures related to the project must be recorded in a separate project fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

- <u>Section</u> 1. That a special fund designated the Ashbourne and Roosevelt Project Fund is hereby established to record all revenue and expenses related to the Ashbourne Improvements Project.
 - <u>Section 2</u>. That \$5,548,001 is hereby appropriated from the Ashbourne and Roosevelt Project Fund for the purpose recording the revenue and expenses related to the project.
- <u>Section 3</u>. That transfers from the Water, Sewer and Road and Alley Funds of \$438,402, \$65,760 and \$43,840 respectively to the Ashbourne and Roosevelt Project Fund are hereby authorized.
- Section 4. That the appropriation in the Road and Alley Fund for the annual street program is hereby reduced by \$43,840.
- <u>Section 5.</u> That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
