**AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE AN AGENCY FUND DESIGNATED THE 396 NORTH CASSADY AVENUE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANUP FUND TO RECORD THE GRANT MONEY RECEIVED BY THE CITY FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF MAKING DISBURSEMENTS TO THE CONTRACTORS COMPLETING THE PROJECT AUTHORIZED BY THIS GRANT AND TO UNAPPROPRIATE \$490,163 INCLUDED IN THE ORIGINAL BUDGET IN THE GRANTS DEPARTMENT.**

**Whereas,** The City has worked with the property owner of 396 North Cassady to secure funding for the environmental remediation of the petroleum contaminated site; and

**Whereas,** The project, which directly benefits a private property owner, is not a "public improvement" as outlined in Bexley City Charter Section 59; and

**Whereas,** The receipts and expenditures related to this grant must be recorded in an agency fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**

**Section 1.** That an agency fund designated the 396 North Cassady Avenue Environmental Cleanup Fund is hereby created.

**Section 2.** That \$490,163 is hereby unappropriated from the Grants Department in the General Fund.

**Section 3.** That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
