**A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING CONGRATULATIONS TO PRESIDENT  
ELIZABETH PAUL, Ph.D. ON HER INAUGURATION AS THE 16<sup>TH</sup> PRESIDENT  
OF CAPITAL UNIVERSITY AND WELCOMING HER TO BEXLEY**


- Whereas,** Capital University, established in 1830 in what is now downtown Columbus, and in 1870 transferred its facilities from near what is now Goodale Park in Columbus, to what is now the City of Bexley, forty-eight years preceding the establishment of the Village of Bexley in 1908; and
- Whereas,** Capital University is the largest employer in the City of Bexley; and
- Whereas,** Capital University is an integral part of the diverse fabric of life in the City of Bexley, bringing students, faculty, staff, visitors, parents, noted speakers and guests, as well as countless sporting, cultural, artistic, medical and business events from around the Columbus metropolitan area, Ohio, the United States and the world to The City; and
- Whereas,** The leadership of President of Capital University is key to the success of the University and by extension plays a key role in the success and vibrancy of the City of Bexley; and
- Whereas,** Dr Paul chose to, upon accepting the presidential position, to re-locate her family to a home in the City of Bexley rather than somewhere else in the Columbus metropolitan region; and
- Whereas,** The Bexley City Council appreciates the positive aspects that the Capital University brings to the City and the vital role that The President of Capital University plays in making those aspects possible; and
- Whereas,** April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 has been declared a "Day of Recognition and Celebration of the Inauguration of President Beth Paul as the 16<sup>th</sup> President of Capital University" by Mayoral proclamation;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:**



**Section 2:** This resolution shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


