

ORDINANCE NO. 09 – 17

An Ordinance to authorize the creation of a Communications Coordinator position with a pay scale as detailed in Exhibit A; the transfer of \$15,000 from Development/Communications Consulting into Salaries and Wages within the Development Department; and the transfer of \$7,000 from the General Fund into Salaries and Wages within the Development Department; and the appropriation of \$22,000 within Development Department Salaries and Wages

WHEREAS, Communications functions within the City have become increasingly important to City operations, as evidenced most recently by the findings of the 2017 Bexley Community Survey; and

WHEREAS, The City has at various times relied on full-time dedicated staff, interns, and paid consultants to assist with this function; and

WHEREAS, With a renewed emphasis on communication to residents, and specifically on expanding communication to additional methods in order to better reach all populations of the City, the administration is proposing the renewal of a dedicated communications position in the form of the proposed Communications Coordinator position;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1:

That Council hereby authorizes the creation of a Communications Manager position with the pay scale as detailed in Exhibit A.

Section 2:


That the following transfers will be made into the Salaries and Wages section of the Development Department:


