A resolution adopting the Bexley Zero Waste Plan

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley underwent a Zero Waste Plan planning effort in 2017; and

WHEREAS, The Bexley Zero Waste Plan is a multi-year plan intended to dramatically reduce the contribution of solid waste to the landfill from Bexley's residents, businesses, and institutions; and

WHEREAS, Reducing solid waste to landfills is best achieved by diverting recyclable, reusable, and compostable materials for more productive use elsewhere; and

WHEREAS, the Zero Waste Plan steering committee was comprised of a dedicated group of volunteers from Bexley's institutions, businesses, partners, and resident base; and

WHEREAS, the Zero Waste Plan will help to inform policy and City initiatives around waste disposal for years to come; and

WHEREAS, Bexley has a history of being a leader in solid waste diversion and green efforts, and the Zero Waste Plan will be the first of its kind adopted by a municipality in central Ohio;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

That this Council hereby adopts the Bexley Zero Waste Plan and will work to further waste diversion by supporting efforts to implement the suggestions provided by the Plan.

Section 2.

That City Council will carefully consider all elements of the Plan, and provide funding as Council deems appropriate and as funding is available.

Section 3.

That this Resolution shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
