

ORDINANCE NO. 17 – 17

An Ordinance to appropriate of \$290,000 from the Recreation Fund in order to pay for costs associated with the development of athletic fields at Schneider Park.

WHEREAS, Costs associated with the development of the athletic fields at Schneider Park have increased based upon required environmental remediation at the site, which was formerly used as a landfill; and

WHEREAS, This project is a priority for the City of Bexley, in that it helps to clean up a former landfill, provide much needed green space, and help to stabilize the southwest portion of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1:

That \$290,000 is hereby appropriated from the Recreation Fund for the purpose of paying costs associated with the development of athletic fields at Schneider Park.

Section 2:

That this Ordinance shall go into force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
