

ORDINANCE NO. 25 - 17

Introduced by: Richard Sharp

An ordinance to authorize the Mayor and Auditor to execute a contract on behalf of the City of Bexley with the Franklin County Board of Health for the provision of health department and plumbing inspection services to the City of Bexley, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the 2018 Franklin County Board of Health contract, attached hereto as "Exhibit A", has been prepared for review by the City; and

WHEREAS, engaging with the Franklin County Board of Health for health department services continues to provide a more affordable and effective solution compared to having a department in-house or contracting with any adjacent Cities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1.

That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to execute the 2018 Franklin County Public Health Services Contract in a substantially similar form as that attached to this Ordinance as "Exhibit A".

Section 2.

That this Ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
