

AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 28 - 17

An Ordinance authorizing a contract between the City of Bexley and the City of Columbus, Ohio for the provision by the City of Columbus of fire protection and emergency medical service for the five year period beginning January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2022.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1.

That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed, on behalf of the City, to execute and deliver a contract with the City of Columbus, Ohio for the provision by the City of Columbus of fire protection and emergency medical service for the five year period beginning January 1, 2018 and ending December 31, 2022 in substantially the form and on the terms set forth in the contract attached to this Ordinance and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2.

That this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety or welfare, and shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
