A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS BY THE CITY OF COLUMBUS ON LIVINGSTON AND CASSADY AVENUES

WHEREAS, These projects provide urgently needed capacity and enhancements to the transportation infrastructure within these areas; and

WHEREAS, These projects will not only make the area safer for vehicular traffic, but for pedestrians and cyclists as well; and

WHEREAS, The addition of sidewalks and bike lanes will support the demand for multimodal options; and

WHEREAS, These projects have the potential to boost economic growth and improve safety for all transportation users.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio:

SECTION 1.

That Bexley City Council supports the funding application to the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission for the purpose of corridor improvements along both Livingston Avenue from Castlegate Road to Woodcrest Road, and Cassady Avenue from Seventh Avenue to Demonye Road.

The portion along Livingston Avenue would include partial/full-depth pavement repairs, milling/resurfacing, curb repair, ADA ramp upgrades, installation of concrete bus pads where appropriate, as well as pavement marking and loop detector replacement.

The portion along Cassady Avenue would include upgraded storm sewers, the addition of curb and gutter, partial/full-depth pavement repairs as needed, milling/resurfacing, and the incorporation of complete street facilities, including street lighting, street trees, and bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

SECTION 2.

That this Resolution of Support shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.


