**An Ordinance to establish rates for part time and casual employees of the City of Bexley, effective as of January 1, 2019.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO**

**Section 1.** That all part time, temporary and casual employees will be paid hourly as follows:



**Section 2.** That all above employees will be paid either weekly or biweekly as determined by the City.


**Section 3.** That the provisions of this ordinance shall take effect as of January 1, 2019.
