## AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, INC. AND THE CITY OF BEXLEY

**Whereas**, the dispatchers and animal control officer in the Bexley Police Department are represented by the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. for purposes of collective bargaining; and

**Whereas**, the previous collective bargaining agreement between the FOP and the City expired on December 31, 2018; and

**Whereas**, the parties have been engaged in negotiations for a successor collective bargaining agreement in accordance with Chapter 4117 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

**Whereas**, the parties have reached a tentative agreement on a successor collective bargaining agreement for the dispatchers to be effective from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021; and

**Whereas**, the parties have reached a tentative agreement on a successor collective bargaining agreement for the animal control officer to be effective from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2021

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio:

**Section 1**: The Bexley City Council hereby approves the successor collective bargaining agreements attached hereto as Exhibit A and authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement.

**Section 2**: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and shall go into full force and effect upon the approval of the Mayor.
