## **ORDINANCE NO. 28 - 19**

An ordinance confirming the Mayor's appointment of Andrew Bashore to the position of Service Director; to vacate the positions of Assistant Service Director, Water Department Foreman, and Streets Department Foreman; to create the position of Water and Sewer Supervisor; to create the position of Streets Supervisor; and to amend the pay scale to accommodate the newly created positions

- WHEREAS, Per the Bexley City Charter the Mayor may appoint a Service Director subject to the confirmation of Bexley City Council; and
- WHEREAS, The Mayor has identified Andrew Bashore as a competent and capable choice for the office of Service Director; and
- WHEREAS, The Mayor is restructuring the Service Department leadership structure to eliminate the position of Assistant Service Director and to transition the position of Water Department Foreman to Water and Sewer Supervisor and to transition the position of Street Department Foreman to Street Department Supervisor; and
- WHEREAS, The proposed restructuring is anticipated to result in a more effective, lateral hierarchy within the Service Department, and is projected to result in an annual savings of approximately \$80,000;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

- Section 1. This Council hereby confirms the appointment of Andrew Bashore to the position of Service Director.
- Section 2. That the positions of Assistant Service Director, Water Department Foreman, and Streets Department Foreman shall be vacated.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the position of Water and Sewer Department Supervisor shall be created.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That the position of Streets Department Supervisor shall be created.
- Section 5. That the "Parks/Forestry Supervisor" category within the employee pay scale be renamed "Service Department Supervisors" and be applicable to the positions of Parks/Forestry Supervisor, Parks Supervisor, Water and Sewer Supervisor, and Street Department Supervisor.
- Section 6. That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
