

**RESOLUTION NO. 02 - 20**

**A Resolution establishing the official date of Independence Day celebrations based upon the calendar date of the Fourth of July.**

**WHEREAS**, The City of Bexley hosts, bar none, the finest and most enthusiastic celebration of the Fourth of July; and

**WHEREAS**, the date of celebration of the festivities has typically fallen on the fourth of July except when that day was a Sunday; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the expressed desire of the Mayor, Bexley City Council, and the leadership of the Bexley Celebrations Association to provide for a consistent, reliable, and equitable formula for determining the appropriate date on which to host community Fourth of July celebrations; and

**WHEREAS**, it is hereby resolved that holding community Fourth of July celebrations on the same day as it falls on the calendar is the most appropriate, consistent and reliable system for determining the date of community celebrations;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Bexley, County of Franklin, State of Ohio:

**Section 1.** That City of Bexley supported Independence Day celebrations shall be held on the Fourth of July, regardless of which day of the week it may fall.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
