

ORDINANCE NO. 46-20

An Ordinance to revise the Codified Ordinances by adopting current replacement pages and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, certain provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law as required by the Ohio Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the City has heretofore entered into a contract with the Walter H. Drane Company to prepare and publish an annual supplement to the Codified Ordinances which is before Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the ordinances of the City of Bexley, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 2020 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

Section 2. That the following sections and chapters are hereby added, amended or repealed as respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law:

Traffic Code

- 432.41 Wearing earplugs or earphones prohibited.
- 436.02 Permitting operation without valid license; one license permitted.
- 436.09 Display of license plates.
- 438.27 Drivers and passengers required to wear seat belts.
- 442.03 Prerequisites to operation of a commercial vehicle.
- 474.03 Attaching bicycle or sled to vehicle.


General Offenses Code

- 612.07 Open container prohibited.
- 618.02 Abandoning animals.
- 636.17 Criminal child enticement. (Repealed)
- 654.04 Railroad vandalism; criminal trespass; interference with operation of train; grade crossing device vandalism.
- 672.02 Definitions related to weapons and explosives.

Section 3. That the complete text of the sections listed above is set forth in full in the current replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A. Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

Section 4. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and for the further reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of current replacement pages to the officials and residents of the City, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements; therefore this Ordinance shall be in force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.


