

Amended Ordinance 61 - 20

An Ordinance to appropriate \$60,000 from the Coronavirus Fund for the purpose of paying eligible expenses related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHEREAS, the United States, State of Ohio and City of Bexley are experiencing an unprecedented emergency with the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic is placing additional financial burden on the City of Bexley and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Federal CARES Act funds in the amount of \$1,007,745 have been deposited in the Coronavirus Fund through two installments in July and September, for the express purpose of reimbursing the City of Bexley for eligible COVID-19 related expenses; and

WHEREAS, additional funding of \$496,212 was received by the City in October, 2020 from State of Ohio CARES Act disbursements; and

WHEREAS, an additional approximately \$60,000 has been received by the City in November, 2020 from State of Ohio CARES Act disbursements; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

That \$60,000 is hereby appropriated from the Coronavirus Fund, for the purpose of COVID-19 related expenses, subject to the restrictions set forth in section 601(d) of the Social Security Act, as added by section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act").

Section 2.

That this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
