An Ordinance to Approve Changes to the Bexley Civil Service Rules

Whereas, the Bexley Civil Service Commission has voted to approve a change to civil service rules; and

Whereas, section 58 of the Bexley City Charter requires City Council to approve all changes to the civil service rules.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio:

Section 1: The Bexley City Council hereby approves the deletion of rule 16-4(B) as follows:

To be appointed to the position of Chief of Police, the successful candidate must have earned at least a Master's degree, or a higher level graduate degree. There is no specific field of endeavor in which the degree must have been obtained.

<u>Section 2</u>: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, safety and shall go into full force and effect upon the approval of the Mayor.
