## **ORDINANCE NO. 26 - 22**

An ordinance to amend Chapter 1476, Unsafe Buildings, to amend provisions for unsafe sites

WHEREAS, The City of Bexley desires to protect human health and safety; and

It is in the best interests of the community and its residents if the City provides for WHEREAS. an effective process to remedy unsafe site conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

## Section 1.

That Chapter 1476.01 (b) be amended as follows:

All sites which in relation to an existing use constitute a hazard to health by reason of (b) inadequate maintenance, dilapidation or obsolescence, or upon which environmental contamination exceeds applicable state and federal environmental standards for poses a risk or threat to human occupancy or human health, are, for the purpose of this chapter, "unsafe sites." All such unsafe sites are hereby declared to be public nuisances and shall be abated by rehabilitation in accordance with the procedure set forth in this chapter.

## Section 2.

That this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
