An Ordinance to approve the supplier for the City of Bexley Electric Aggregation Program

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 4928 of the Ohio Revised Code, to facilitate competitive retail electricity service to promote electricity savings, lower cost of electricity supplies, and other benefits, certain governmental entities may aggregate certain electricity consumers within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the electors of the City of Bexley have previously approved the City's plan to create an aggregation program for customers located within the boundaries of the City of Bexley during the election that occurred in November, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bexley desires to enter into an agreement for electrical aggregation pursuant to its authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

That this Council hereby selects and uses <u>Dynegy Energy Services</u>, LLC, during the term of the Agreement attached hereto as "Exhibit A", as the exclusive provider of retail electric supply to the members of the Electric Aggregation Program for the implementation and administration of the City's municipal electric aggregation program in accordance with Revised Code 4928.20.

Section 2.

This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health and welfare of the City of Bexley and its residents and shall go into effect upon approval by the Mayor. .
