



**ORDINANCE NO. 37 - 23**

**An ordinance to authorize supplemental appropriations for calendar year 2023.**

**Whereas:** Due to an increase in public special events in both 2022 and 2023, an additional appropriation for special events overtime has been needed each year; and

**Whereas:** Due to increased participation in Jeffrey Summer Camp and Before and After Care that has resulted in a need to increase the salaries and wages budgets in these departments; and

**Whereas:** The increased participation in the Jeffrey Summer Camp will generate revenue which more than offsets the increase in the salaries and wages budgets.


