

Ordinance No. 07-24

An Ordinance to Amend Section 262.02(c)(3), Holidays, in order to re-codify Juneteenth as a holiday for non-bargaining unit employees.

Whereas: Ordinance 28-21 amended Section 262.02(c)(3)(A)(B) in order to add Juneteenth as a holiday; and

Whereas: Ordinance 25-22 and Ordinance 04-23 amended Section 262.02(c)(3)(F) in order to provide the Mayor with the ability to grant additional time off preceding or following paid holidays; and,

Whereas: Ordinance 25-22 and Ordinance 04-23 were based off of an earlier version of 262, and inadvertently excluded Juneteenth from the list of holidays included in **Section 262.02(c)(3)(B)**;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Bexley, Ohio:

Section 1.

That Section 262.03(c)(3)(B) of the codified ordinances be amended as follows:


B. All other Schedule I employees. Holidays for all other Schedule I employees will be as follows:

- New Year's Day
- Martin Luther King Jr. Day
- Presidents Day
- Memorial Day
- Juneteenth**
- Independence Day
- Bexley Day (Observed second Monday in August)
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Friday following Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

Section 2.


That this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
