An ordinance to appropriate \$3,800 from the General Fund to the Mosquito Contract Fund to pay the remainder of mosquito control treatments for 2024

Whereas: Franklin County Public Health (FCPH) provides the City of Bexley's mosquito testing and control contract, and FCPH's most recent RFP for a mosquito control vendor resulted in a vendor change from Clarke Environmental to Vector Disease Control International (VDCI); and

Whereas: VDCI's RFP response offered improved mosquito testing and mitigation efforts throughout the county, and as a result of these improvements, the cost for 2024 testing and treatment is projected to be higher than the funds the City budgeted for mosquito control in 2024; and

Whereas: Additional appropriations will allow the City to pay the remaining 2024 mosquito control invoices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY:

Section 1.

That \$3,800 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund into the Mosquito Contract account for the purpose of paying the remaining mosquito control contract payments for 2024.

Section 2.

That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
