

ORDINANCE NO. 32 - 24

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$10,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO FUND THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF COMMUNITY AED STATIONS

Whereas

In line with the City's commitment to community health and wellness, Council passed Ordinance 43-23 on February 13, 2024 to create Chapter 1485 in the Bexley Codified Ordinances to mandate the installation of AED and Bleed Control Kit devices in specified public locations; and

Whereas

The 2024 Budget did include a commitment of \$10,000 from the City's General Fund to support this initiative, with the understanding that these funds would not be appropriated until quotes on installation costs were obtained and in line with project estimates and grant funds were also secured; and

Whereas

Installation quotes have been received and are in line with initial estimates, and grant funding has been awarded for a portion of this project. Appropriation of the budgeted funds is now needed in order to move this lifesaving initiative forward;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY

Section 1.

That \$10,000 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund in order to provide funding for AED and Bleed Control Kit installation in accordance with Chapter 1485 of the Bexley Codified Ordinances; and

Section 2.

That this ordinance shall go into effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
