Bexley Police Department NARRATIVE FOR PATROL OFFICER MELLISON M DAVIS Ref: 24BEX-7792-OF

On 5/26/2024 Bexley officers observed a vehicle operating at high speeds, strike a curb and make a wide turn. Suspecting an intoxicated driver, officers safely caught up to the vehicle and activated their lights and sirens to initiate a traffic stop. The driver failed to adhere to the officers lights and sirens and a vehicle pursuit ensued. During the pursuit the driver failed to obey traffic signals and stop signs, drove left of center, struck and drove over a median, went left of center, drove on the wrong side of the road and operated the vehicle well in excess of the posted speed limits. After a thirteen minute pursuit, the damage to the vehicle, caused by it striking the median in Bexley, resulted in the vehicle becoming inoperable. Bexley officers placed the driver under arrest and she was turned over to OSP for slating. Independent of OSP charges, Bexley officers filed and clerked felony, Failure to Comply-Fleeing and Eluding charges through Franklin County.
