NARRATIVE FOR PATROL SERGEANT EDWARD P GLICK

On 9/19/25 at 0433 hours I was on marked cruiser patrol when I observed the driver of ** ******* commit an improper turn. The driver did not stop and led officers on a vehicle pursuit which ended in the alley behind 989 Fairwood. The driver, Suspect #1, and rear passenger fled the vehicle on foot. Suspect #2, the registered owner, stayed in the vehicle. There was illegal narcotics in plain view and a probable cause search seized apparent crack rocks from the seat of each of the vehicle occupants as well as paraphernalia. Suspect #1 is a known party to officers and Suspect #2 identified him. Warrants to follow.
