central Bexley while also driving in an evasive manner. After Bexley officers caught up to the vehicle Suspect #1 crashed into a tree while turning at S Cassingham and E Mound. Suspect #1 then fled on foot from the vehicle, which caught fire. Suspect #1 continued to flee on foot from officers who gave multiple verbal commands. Eventually Victim Officer #1 engaged in a short foot pursuit with Suspect #1. The officer deployed a TASER with no effect.

Suspect #1 fell on the ice and Victim Officer #1 attempted to take the suspect into custody. Suspect #1 resisted and then took the officer to the ground and got on top, no longer attempting to escape. The officer was able to gain a position of advantage and Suspect #1 was handcuffed when another officer arrived on scene.

Suspect #1 was visibly intoxicated and, after being cleared by CFD Medics, was transported to BPD. He was read and shown the BMV 225 and refused to provide a breath sample. Suspect #1 was slated for OVI, hit-skip and failure to control as part of the traffic. Suspect #1 was also slated for F-4 assault and F-5 obstructing official business by fleeing and creating a risk of physical harm.
