NARRATIVE FOR PATROL OFFICER PETER S MCCOLLAM

On 12/28/24 at approximately 1030 hrs, a teller at the PNC Bank located at 2594 E. Main St., received a telephone call from an unknown individual who made threats to come to the branch and "rob" it and "kill everyone". The offender then hung up the phone.

The teller who received the call, *****, said that she was at the teller station (third from the end at the wall) and answered the phone. She began her prescribed answer message but was immediately interrupted by the caller who stated that they would come to the bank and proceed to rob it and then kill everyone inside the branch before abruptly hanging up. She reported that the caller sounded like a male who was older with no accent who spoke with a clear and fast speech. He mentioned something regarding PNC investments during his tirade.

Contact with the PNC Bank security/loss prevention would be needed to retrieve the call, which was recorded. ***** said that she moves between branches for PNC. The bank manager *** reported that there had been no unusual activity or disturbances leading up to the phone call.
